

jeff bezos yacht rotterdam

Jeff Bezos, the founder and CEO of Amazon, recently took delivery of his new \$400 million yacht in Rotterdam. The yacht, named the “Flying Dutchman”, is said to be the most expensive yacht ever built.

The yacht is reported to be over 100 meters long and is said to have two helipads, a swimming pool, and a cinema. It is also said to be able to accommodate up to 16 guests in its eight staterooms.

Bezos is no stranger to luxury yachts, as he already owns the “Rising Sun”, which is the world’s second largest yacht. He is also said to be the owner of the largest private residence in the world, which is located in Washington state.
